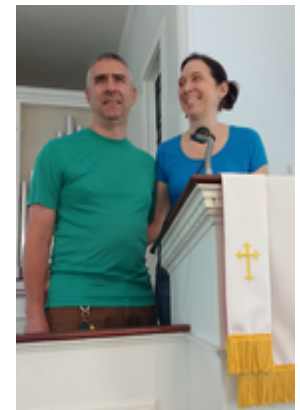


Esperre Kay Newsletter – July/August 2018
