



"The Centre of Loving Hands Orphanage, located in Turbe', Haiti, was founded in 1996 by Pastor Jean Siliac. Following his death in 2003, Yvette Siliac, his wife, became the sole owner of the orphanage. In 2009 Loving Hands was in financial strain when God led two separate mission teams to the orphanage, one from Rhode Island and one from Michigan. Since then He has provided sponsors for the children and has called Christian mission teams to improve the facility."
