## Sponsorship Update

A HUGE thank you to those of you who have stepped forward in the last few weeks to sponsor. Jesula and Myrèse are now completely sponsored, praise God! Currently we have four more young adults in the program who need sponsorship. No monthly amount is too small. This is your chance to reach out and help a young adult orphan receive Christian discipleship and an education so they have an opportunity to build a better life for themselves and to spread the Gospel in Haiti. Our needs are:

- Kasalineda:** \$70/month for education, \$5/month for basic needs
- Olivier:** \$75/month for education
- Peterson:** \$80/month for education
- Stevenson:** \$30/month for education, \$70/month for basic needs

## Update on Schools and Travel

As of right now, the plan in Haiti is for high school students to return to classes this month (August). They will finish out the 2019-2020 school year, have final exams in October and begin the new school year in November. For university students they have a similar plan only the students will end their school year in November and begin the new year in December. Please pray there is nothing to stand in the way of having school this year. Pray all our students do well and for their safety every day. Pray this does not cause a large spike in COVID cases and that schools will take precautions. Our plan is to return to Haiti the end of August. Please pray for us as there are a lot of new requirements for flying into Haiti. Pray also for God's provision once we arrive. We are looking forward to being with the young adults, the orphans at Loving Hands and all of our loved ones in Haiti once again. We are excited to get back to the work the Lord has for us there. Thank you for your prayers, they mean the world to all of us.
