No words could express our most recent trip to Haiti better than this hymn. We sensed the Lord's faithful presence, leading and guiding us the entire time.

While in Haiti, we had the opportunity to gather with our young adults several times for Bible study and individual meetings. We explained to them about moving back to the US. They were a little sad but understood God calling us home. We explained how we plan to stay in touch with them and hope to return for a visit soon, God willing.

We also met with the director of Pastor Martinez's school where several of our young adults have attended and Mirlande still attends. We told him we would no longer be living full time in Haiti. He thanked us for our partnership with the school over these past five years and told us we will be missed. We thanked him for his help with our students.

We also spent a lot of our time packing up the Espere Kay house. The Lord provided an opportunity for us to bless a missionary friend in Haiti with all the items from our house. God gave us all we needed to both pack up and move

everything, including a truck and helpers from Haiti Teen Challenge and Celebrate Recovery!

During the time of the move there was a situation that arose in Haiti. A prominent gang kidnapped 16 Americans and 1 Canadian. This put a spotlight on Haiti for awhile and brought attention to the current situation there. This year alone there have been over 800 kidnappings. No one is immune. Many of you contacted us and let us know you were praying for us and concerned for our safety. Thank you! Praise God, we were able to clear out the house without incident and we safely traveled to a guesthouse for our last night in country and then to the airport the next day.

We discussed the EK young adults both past and present and children at Loving Hands. What blessed times of fellowship we had talking and praying with all these lovely people. We are so grateful God opened the door for us to have this time with wonderful friends.
